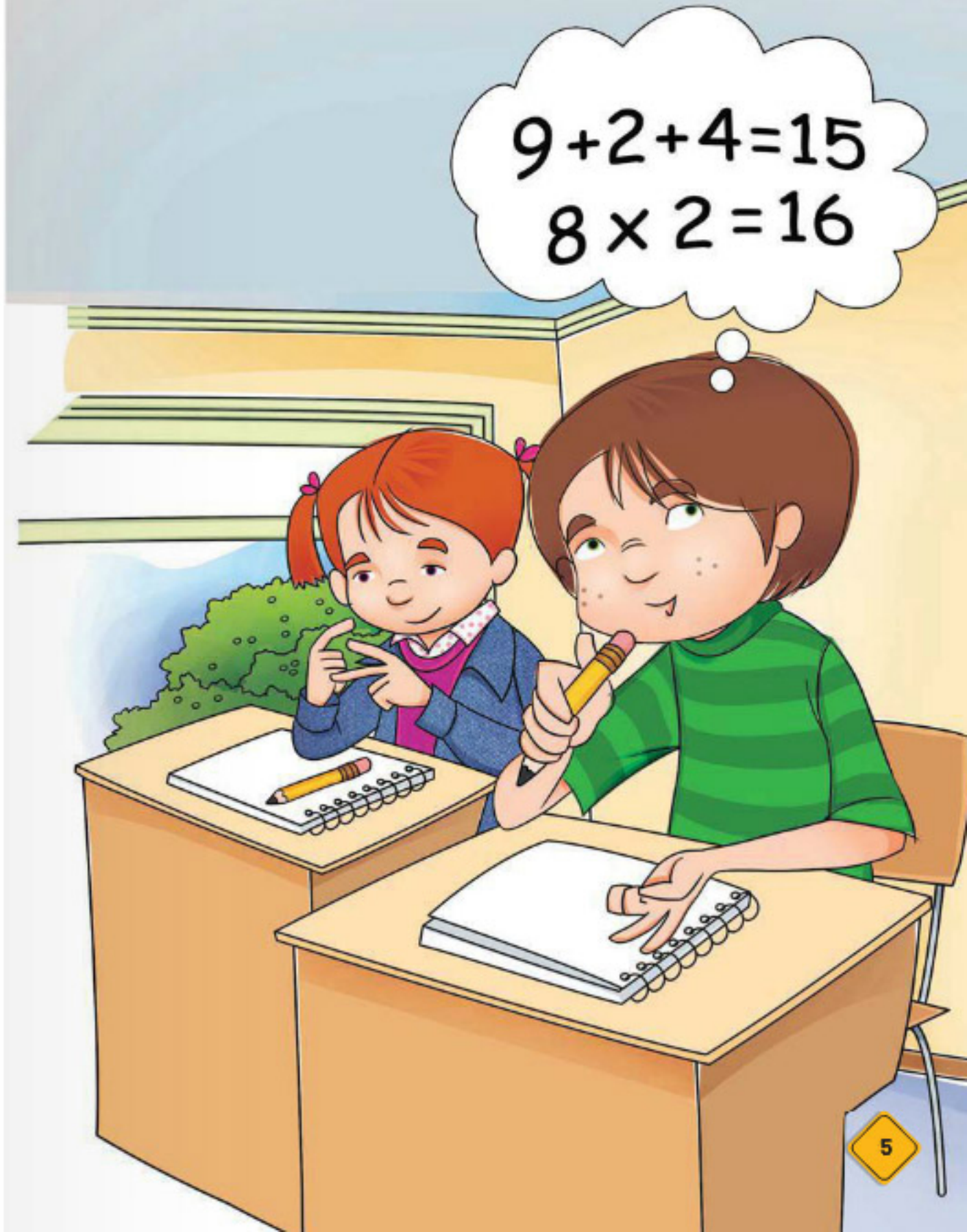
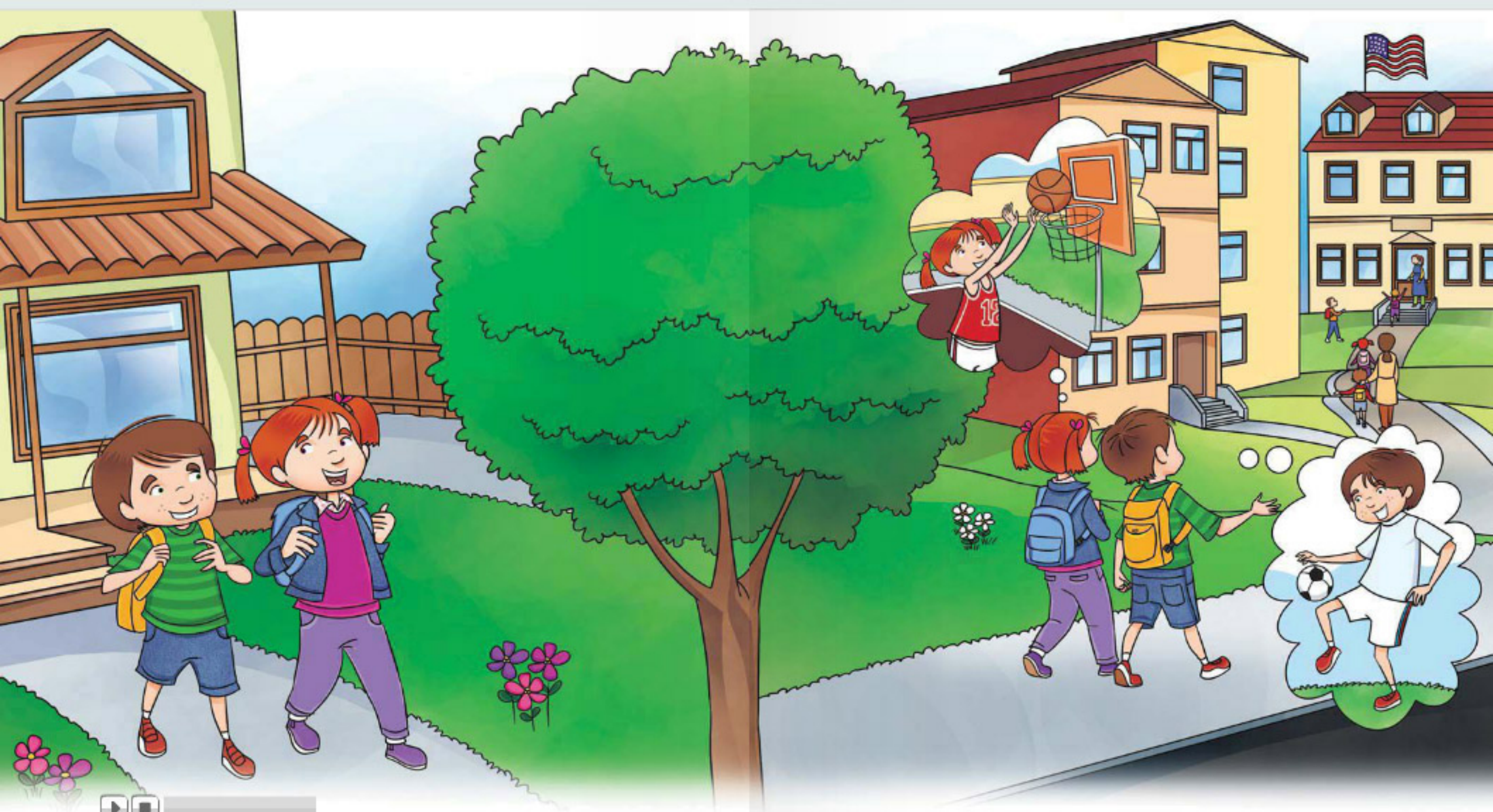




Todd's Plan

It is the first day of a new school year. Todd is on the way to school with his friend Jenny.

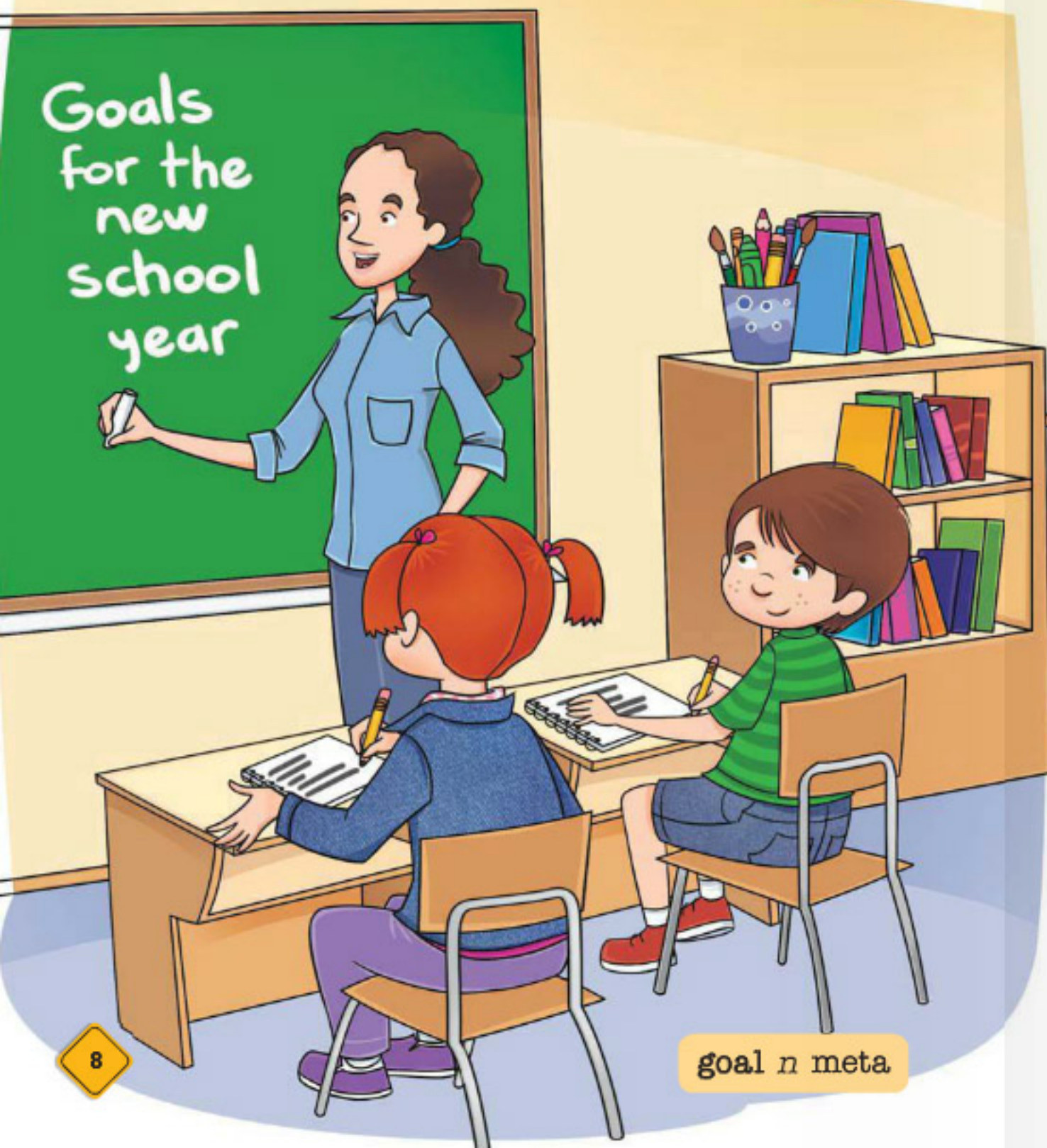
“I think science will be fun this year,” Jenny says.

“Are you going to practice a sport this year?” Todd asks.

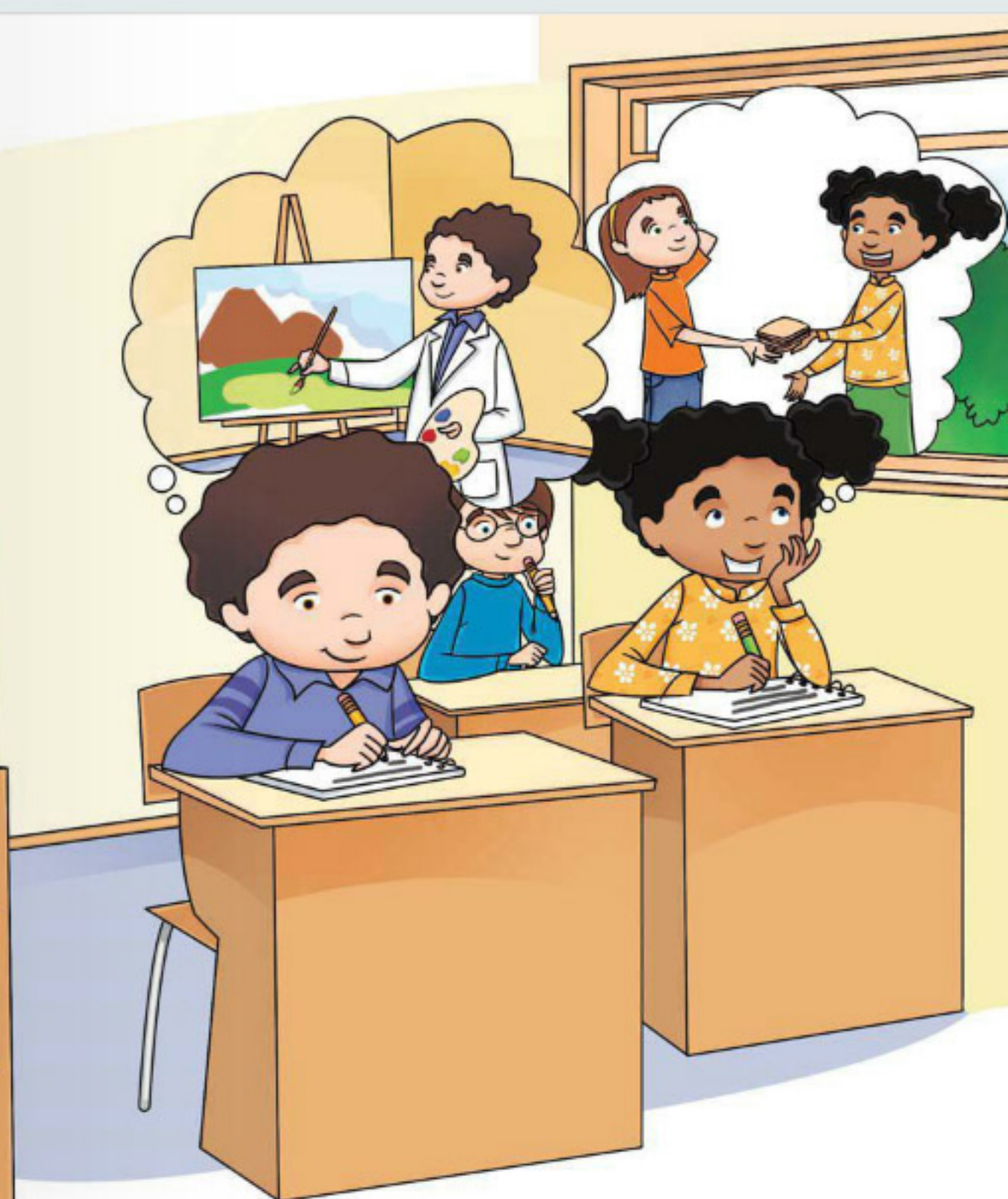
“Yes, I think I’ll practice basketball,” says Jenny. “How about you?”

The children think about what they want to achieve this year. Mark is going to paint great pictures. Sharon is going to make a new friend.

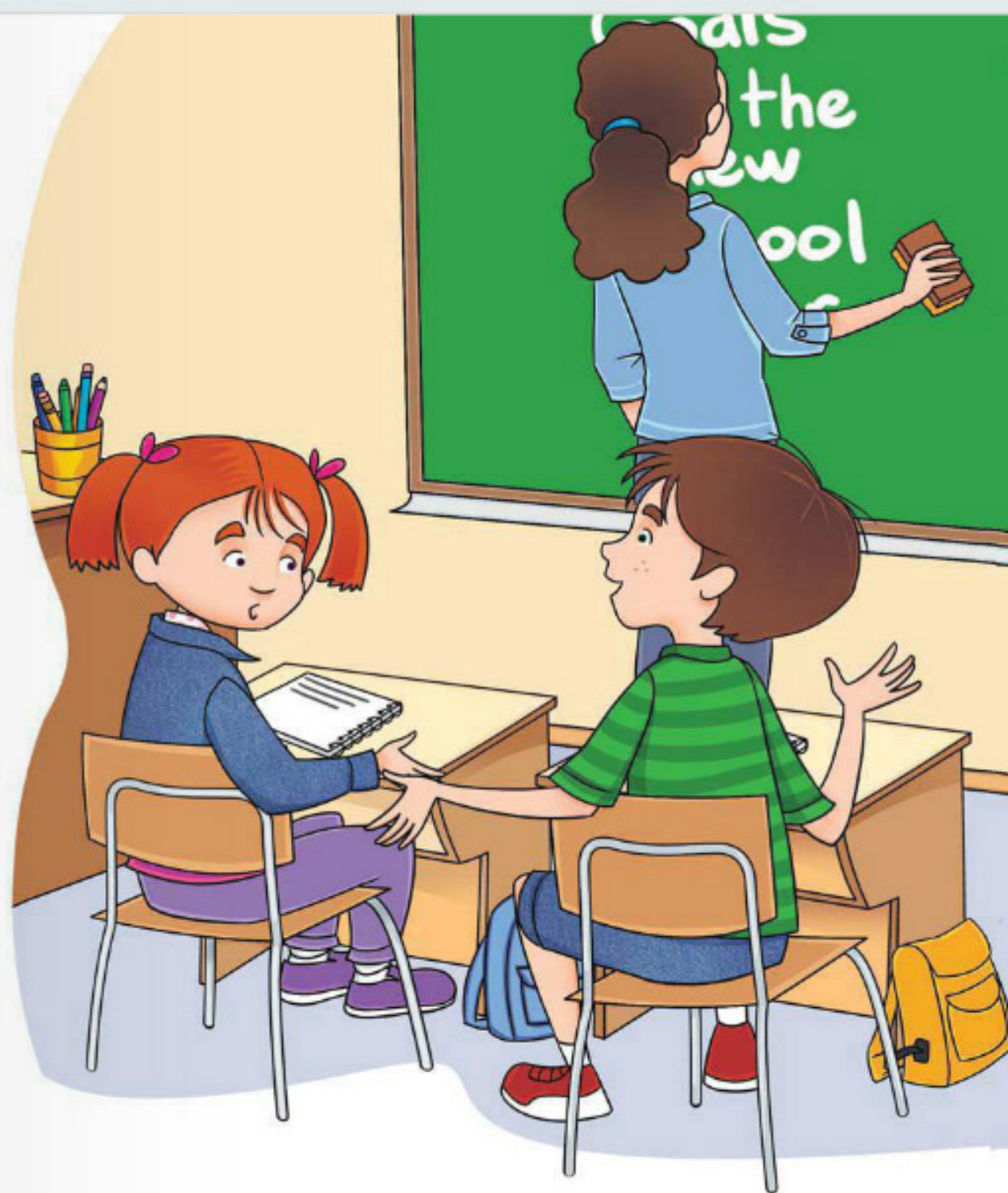

"I'm going to get an A in math," Todd says.

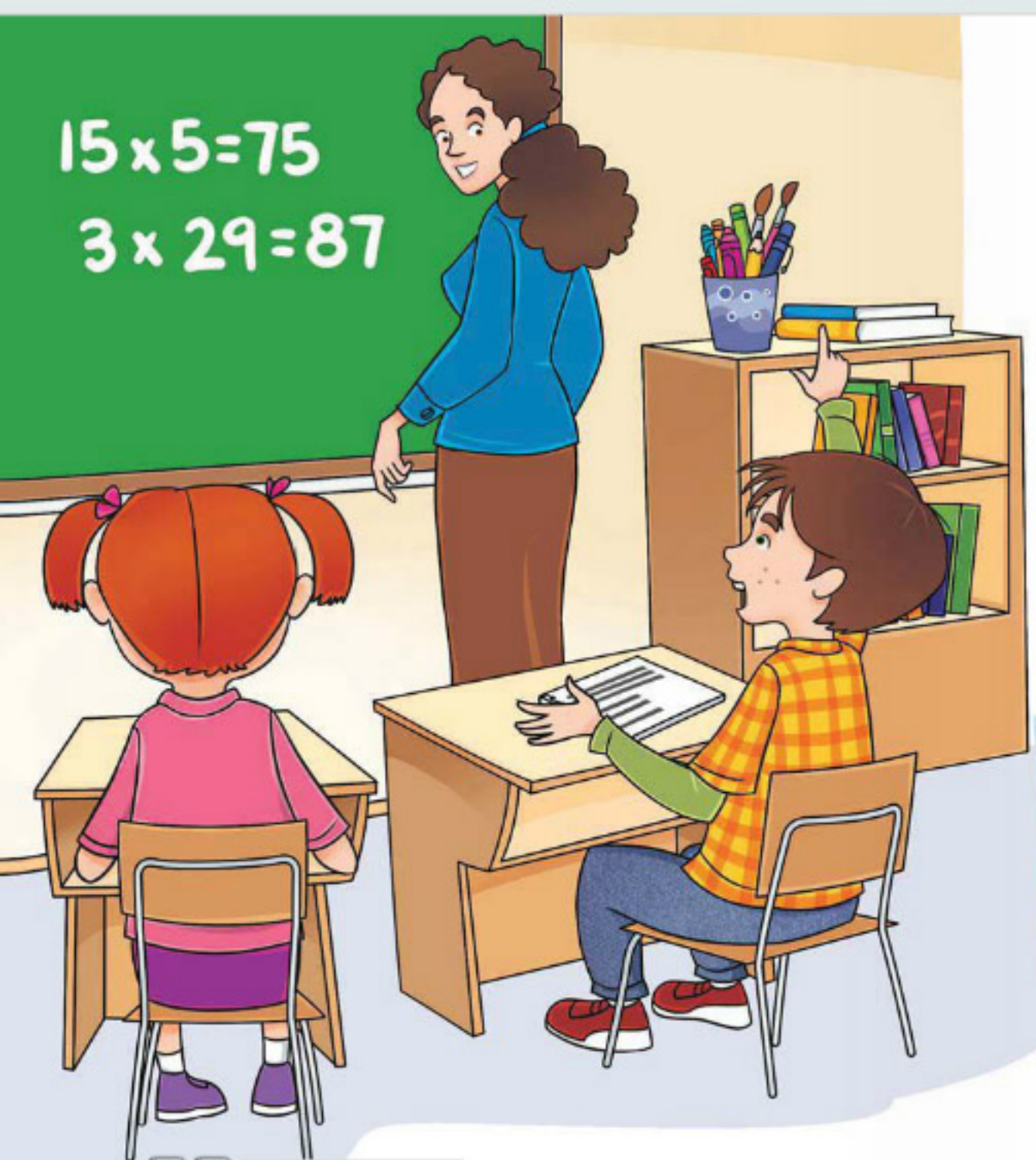
Everyone is impressed. Todd is not very good at math.

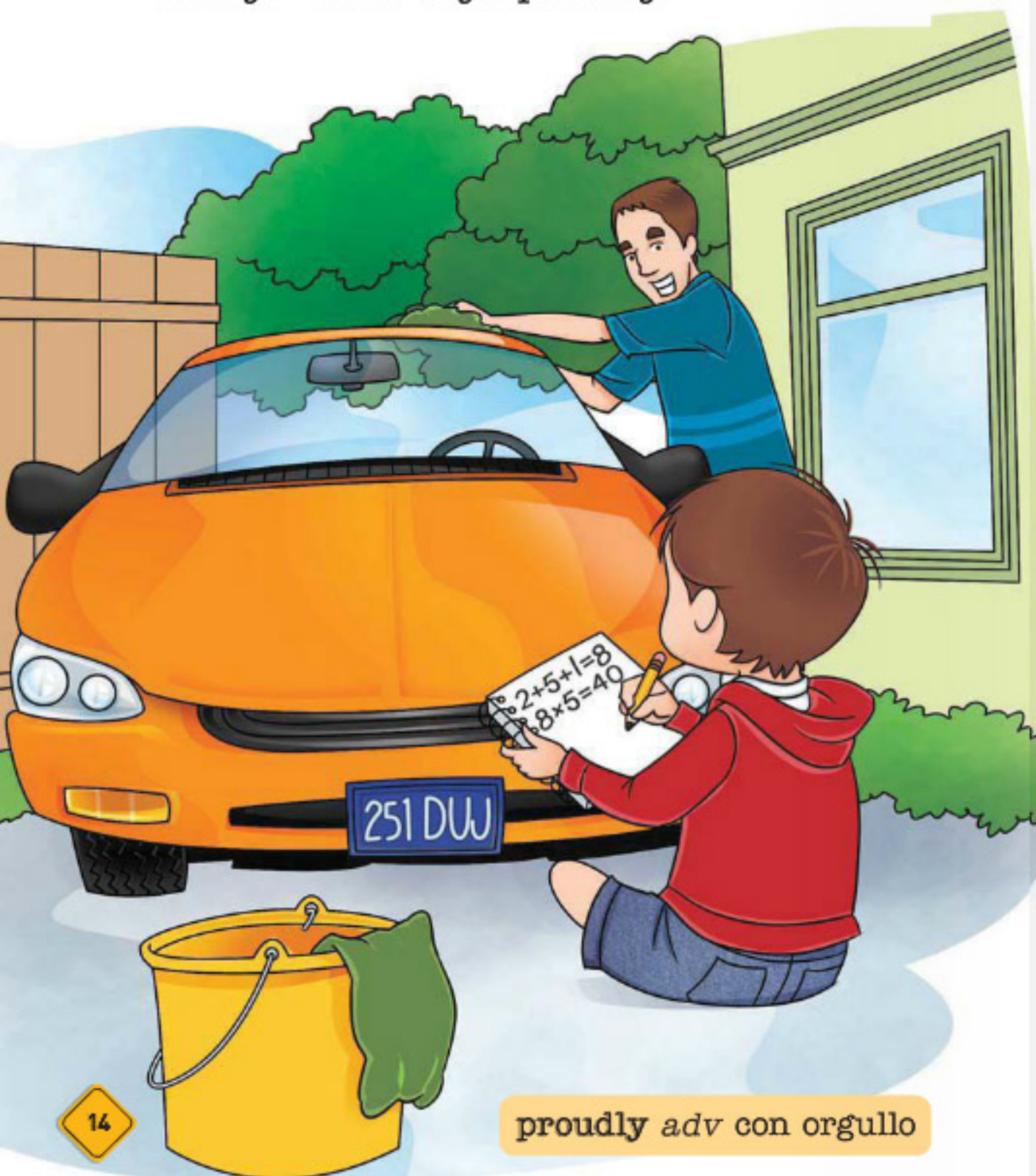


Todd adds the numbers on his dad's car.
